Fellow Democrats, we are preparing for the big election on March 2nd. We still need a few more election workers. Call me at 450-0018 or the Elections Office at 659-6541 if you want to help. We are allowed to make last minute emergency appointments. Also on March 2nd, after the polls close, we will hold precinct caucuses at 7:15 PM. By the time you receive this newsletter, we will have held training on February 18th, but I have available for you an excerpt from the party rules plus parliamentary procedure handouts. A kit will be presented at the March 1st meeting to illustrate how to hold a precinct caucus. The well-attended caucuses of 2008 are not expected this year. The most important items of business at the caucuses will be the election of delegates and alternates to the county convention, plus the introduction of resolutions concerning important issues for the party to consider at the county and state conventions. The county convention will be held on Saturday, March 20th, at 9 AM at the Southside Recreation Center meeting room, 2750 Ben

Ficklin Road. The state convention will begin on Friday, June 25th in Corpus Christi.

The Bill White campaign has been in touch with me and Manny Campos. They are hoping to avoid a run-off with Farouk Shami. Former Congressman Stenholm has mailed a letter supporting White to his old congressional district. Most of us believe that White is the candidate with the best chance of winning in November, and his qualifications are fantastic.
